

- The M-I-T Student Mobility Pilot Project
 - Initiated in 2009
 - o Launched in 2010
- Changed the name to AIMS to accommodate future members
- Multi-lateral framework:Ministries and HEIs
- Government scholarships
- Student exchanges based on bi-lateral agreements

- Study fields collectively determined by participating countries
- HEIs sharing curriculum and syllabus


