

Social Enterprises in the UK

- A social enterprise is an organization that applies commercial strategies to maximize improvements in human and environmental well-being, rather than maximizing profits for external shareholders.
- There are seven types of structure for social enterprises in the UK as shown in the model here.



Social Enterprise

A social enterprise is a revenue-generating business with primarily social objectives whose surpluses are reinvested for that purpose in the business or in the community, rather than being driven by the need to deliver profit to shareholders and owners..

- There are 4,787,650 small/medium sized organisations in the UK of which 283,500 are social enterprises (5.9%) Social Enterprise UK 2010
- 3,557,255 small/medium sized organisations have no employees (213,400 social enterprises 6.0%)
- In the UK, social enterprises contribute £24 Billion to the economy (5.9%) Social Enterprise UK 2010

The model for Goodwill Solutions is that of a commercial logistics business.

It holds stock for overseas manufacturers to facilitate sales for UK based retailers, such as Asda, Sainsbury's and Shop Direct.

With the profit it creates from its Logistics activities,
Goodwill Solutions provides training which leads to employment for disadvantaged individuals.
