





### Work conditions on a student visa



A full time course at degree level RQF Level 6 (and equivalents) or above sponsored by a UK recognised body or a body in receipt of public funding as a Higher Education Institution.

20 hours per week during term time Full-time during vacations.

## **Unsuccessful applications – Common reasons**

- Not including the correct supporting documents or submitting documents without translations.
- Forgetting to get a Tuberculosis and/or ATAS Certificate (if applicable).
- ✤ Failing to disclose full travel or immigration history.



### **Graduate Route**

This route is for international students who want to work following the successful completion of a course of study at UK bachelor's degree-level or above.

#### Eligibility

- ➢ Must be in the UK
- Must have a Student visa
- > Studied a UK bachelor's degree level or above
- You've completed the course

#### Duration

- ≥ 2 years
- ➤ 3 years (PHD students)



# Changes to student visa route

Limit the right to bring dependants on the student route other than those on postgraduate research programmes;

Remove the ability to switch out of student routes into work routes before successful completion of studies and review the maintenance requirements.

The changes are effective and will apply to students starting courses in <u>January</u> 2024.
