BioMedical Admissions Test (BMAT)

30 October 2019

ABOUT BMAT

BMAT is a subject-specific admissions test taken by applicants to assess their academic potential for demanding biomedical degree courses.

BMAT is owned and administered by Cambridge Assessment Admissions Testing consisting of a 2-hour test in 3 sections:

Section 1: Aptitude & Skills - 60 minutes (multiple-choice)

Section 2: Scientific Knowledge & Applications - 30 minutes (multiple-choice)

Section 3: Writing Task - 30 minutes (Essay question)

BEFORE REGISTRATION

1. Ensure you have understood all information about BMAT test format and its regulation
2. Read all information in the **Registration Guide** and **Notice to Candidates**.
3. Please note that applicants must only take BMAT **once** in an admissions cycle. Those taking BMAT – August *must not* register for BMAT – October.
4. **There will be no refund once you have registered.**

HOW TO REGISTER

- You can save and resume your current application from a link sent to your email.

2. Upload required documents

- A copy of your passport or Thai National ID Card
- Consent form signed by your guardian (If you are below 18 as of the test date)
- Payment slip (If you make a payment via bank transfer)

3. Make a payment

3.1) Bank Transfer

- Transfer the exam fee to British Council bank account, upload the payment slip in your application along with the transfer date

3.2) In-person at British Council Siam Square

- Show confirmation email of your submitted application to [Exams Customer Management Team](#)
- Pay by Credit card or debit card (VISA/ Master Card). *Cash is not accepted*

A confirmation email with your entry number, test venue and any updates will be sent to you by 22 October 2019

On the test day

1. Please present your **Thai national ID card or passport** as a proof of identity.
You will not be allowed to take the test without the proof of identity above.
2. Please bring your own stationery. Black ball point pen and HB pencils are required for the test.
3. You will receive your login details to view your result online via *Metritests system* upon the day of the test.

After the test

Results will be released online on 22 November 2019 at 09:00 UK Time. Results will not be provided in hard copies. If you have applied to a university which does not appear on the list, you will be responsible for sharing your result to the university from the systems. Otherwise, your results will be automatically sent to any BMAT institution(s) you have applied to in the UK or LKC (as long as your choices were entered upon your application with us).
