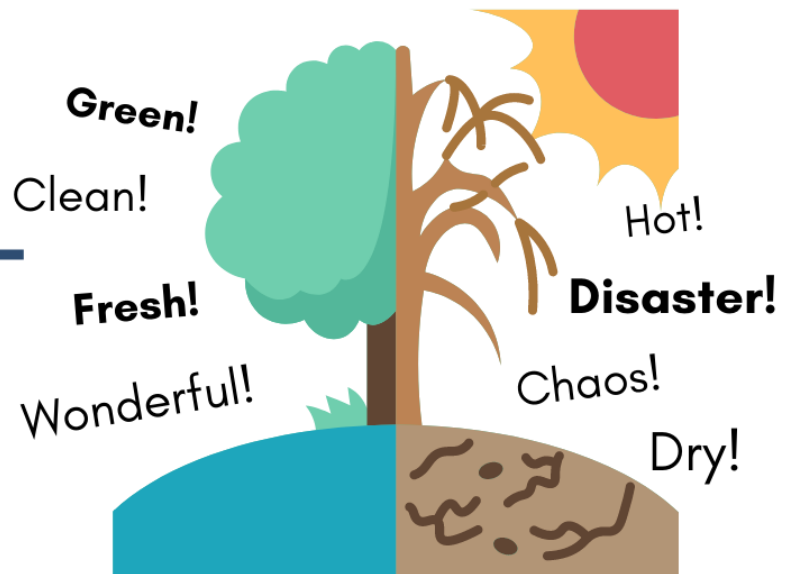
THE PAINFUL CHANGE
