The relationship...

In natural disasters, women and girls do not have the nescessary sanitation to ensure their health, and they are more exposed to harassment in public spaces. Other than that, they also do not have enough time to prepare clothings, books, tools and vehicles to get to school and gain education during the evacuation.

All natural disasters causes people to lose their house, their belongings and their money, and poverty came from this. For girls in Vietnam, they were thought to be less useful than boys because of their weak strength and they do not deserve education. Most of the time, girls in poor household post-disaster will be sent to marry someone or given jobs to do to gain more income for the family, and leave their studies aside.

Why?

Low income and poverty made parents think that boys deserves education more than girls.

How to make it better?

Create campaigns.

Provide needs for girls.

When survival is the most important thing to care about, they will not have time to think about education. They need food, water, money and shelter. Provide them with what they need first, then they will settle and starts to take time and learn,

Free temporary schooling.

Find different methods to educate girls in case of natural disasters and post - disaster. They can't afford money at that time to go to local schools.

Encourage girls who are now in schools but suffered climate change. They knew about them the most so they will find solution to help other girls in need.
