The Impacts of CLIMATE CHANGE ON Girl's education

POSITIVE

CHILD MARRIAGE

Girls are more likely to leave school to get married in times of weather-related crises to help ease the burden of scarce household resources.

HOUSEHOLD RESPONSIBILITIES

In communities affected by drought, girls may have to walk further to collect water for cooking, cleaning, and drinking which will have a direct impact on time available for education.

GENDER INEQUALITIES

Vulnerable households often cope with climate shocks and stresses by pulling children out of school, usually starting with girls because of discriminatory gender norms. Moreover, in the event of weather-related school closures, girls are less likely than boys to attend temporary school.

Climate change education that builds awareness of climate vulnerability is a way to empower young people, especially girls with appropriate **SKILLS, KNOWLEDGE**, and **CRITICAL THINKING** to take action to fight for **CLIMATE JUSTICE**.

Countries that have invested in girl's education have suffered far **FEWER DEATHS** from droughts and floods than countries with lower levels of girl's education.

EDUCATION is the key to building **RESILIENT COMMUNITIES** who are able to adapt to the impacts of climate crises.
