Applying to study in the UK is a straightforward process. All you need to do is to submit a completed application form along with the required documentations through the Universities and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS) system.

In this session, the Managing Director, UCAS International will first give you an overview of how to use the UCAS undergraduate (UG) admissions system and postgraduate (PG) student App to research and apply to higher education institutions in the UK.

Admissions managers from University of Bath and Regent's University London will then walk you through the application process for UG and PG courses in the UK respectively. If you wish to study at a UK university, it is helpful to know about the different entry routes that may be available to you.

The most common entry route for progression to UK universities is through successful completion of secondary education (for UG study) or tertiary education (for PG study) at your home country or globally. However, if you do not meet the academic or English language requirements set by the university that you wish to apply to, a pathways course can help you. These courses are provided by further education colleges, universities and in collaboration with private-sector pathway providers in the UK.

In this session, two pathways programme providers – INTO University Partnerships and ONCAMPUS will give you an overview about the UK's pathways programmes and how it can help international students improve their English skills and give them the confidence to start their undergraduate or postgraduate study. In addition, two of their star alumni are also invited to talk about why they chose to study a pathways course and their journey of getting into the dream universities.


