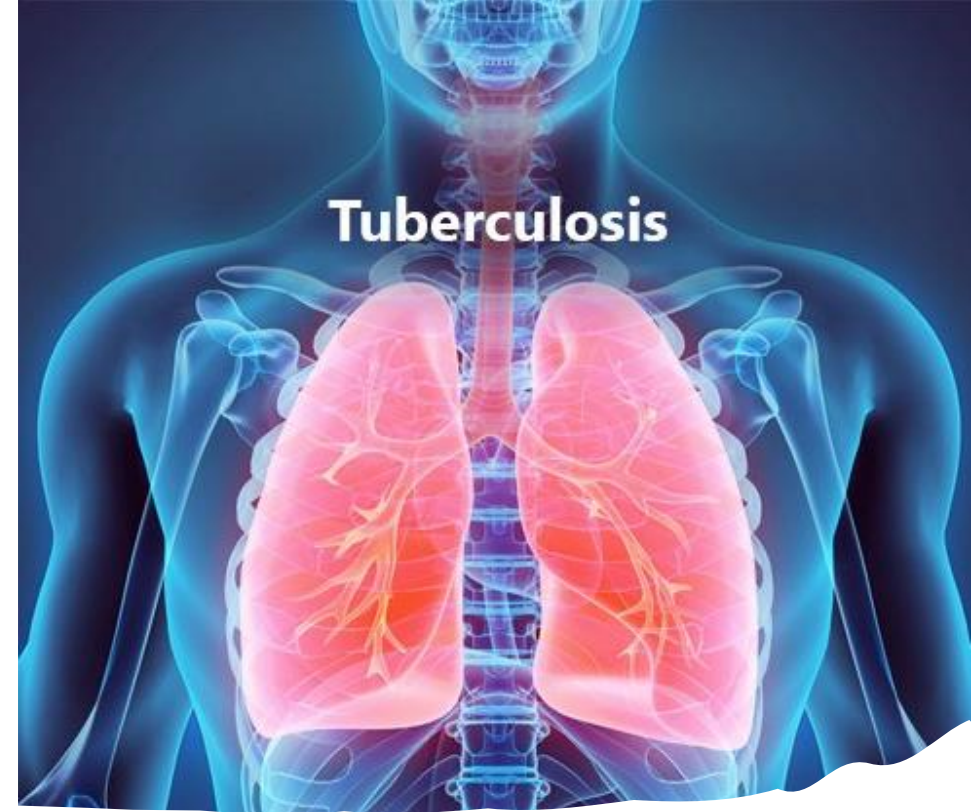

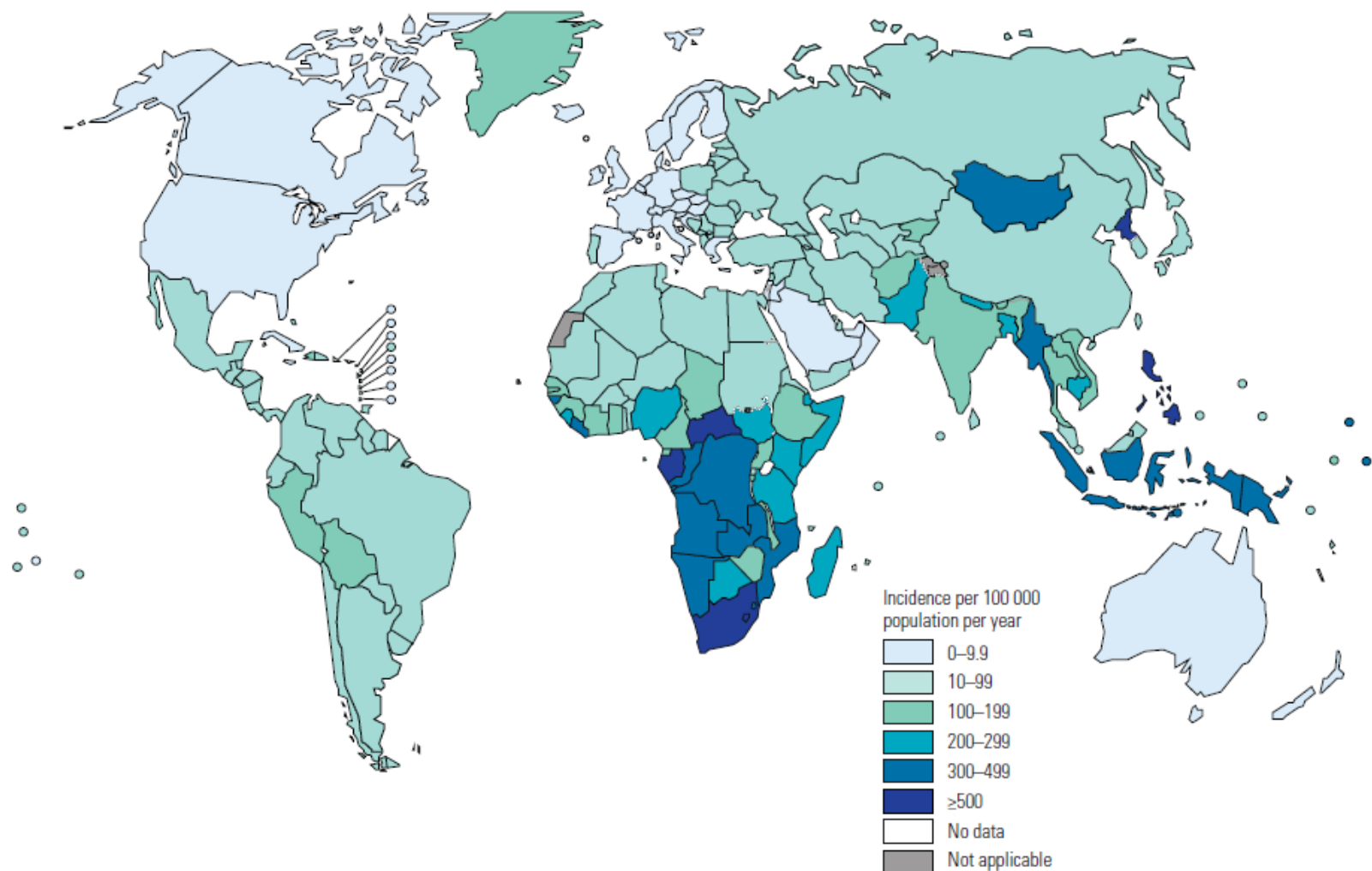

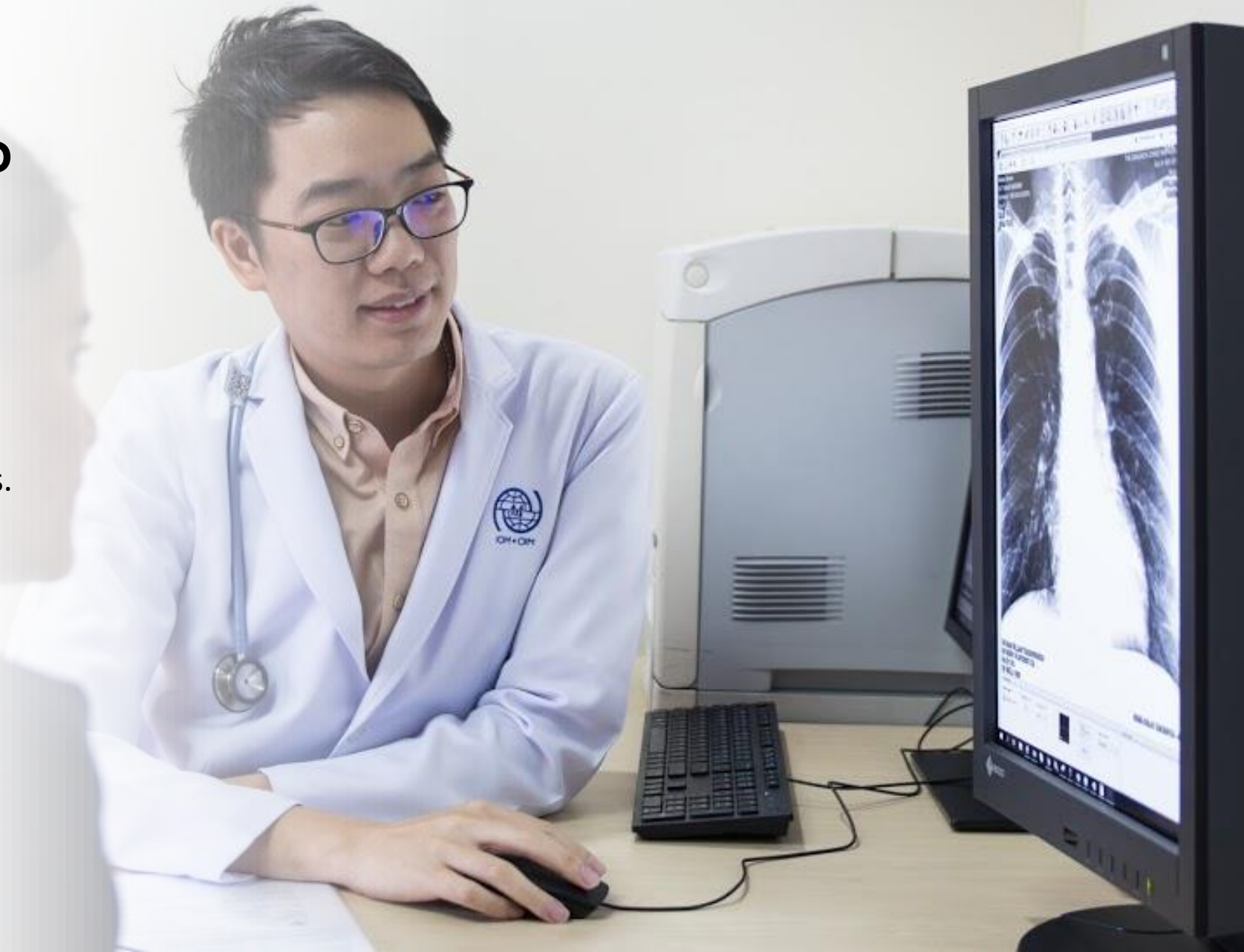
# Why do you need to be screened for TB?

# Who and When needs to be screened for TB?

- Applicant who intend to stay in the UK for over 6 months.
- Applicant who have been resident in a high TB incidence country in the previous 6 months.
- Applicant should apply for TB screening around 10 – 16 weeks prior to departure.

## There are different screening processes for 3 categories



### Adults

- TB symptom and history screening
- Chest x-ray



### Pregnant women

- TB symptom and history screening
- CXR in the second or third trimester if the applicant consents.
- Proceed with sputum test with out chest x-ray



### Children under 11 years old

- TB symptom and history screening
- Physical examination (fee 500 THB)
- Chest x-ray (Only if indicated)

# TB Screening process for adults

## Registration at IOM

- Identity check
- Document verification
- Informed consent
- Pay the fee (4200 THB)

## Chest X-ray

- BCH
- Phayathai2

## Meet IOM Doctor

- TB symptom and history screening
- Inform CXR Result

## Screening outcomes

If your test shows that you do not have TB, you'll be given a certificate which is valid for 6 months from the date of your x-ray



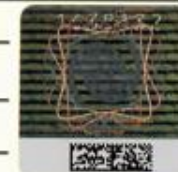

Upon arrival in the UK you should register with a General Practitioner (GP) and give a copy of this certificate for their records. If your chest x-ray shows abnormality requiring follow-up, we will also give you a copy of the chest x-ray and interpretation which you also have to give to the GP.
